- Continue to embed Intensive Interaction as a pedagogical approach to teaching the fundamentals of communication.
- Enhance student learning outcomes through the continued creation of consistent data collection processes for student learning in the areas of Literacy, Numeracy and Communication.
- Continue to train teachers and teacher aides in priorities areas such as reading, digital pedagogies, communication, disability specific pedagogical approaches and Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL).

Our initiatives include

- Appoint Intensive Interaction Coach and support staff through peer feedback and moderation processes. Engage in professional development through Intensive Interaction Australia and UK. Develop an internal Intensive Interaction co-ordinator.
- Identify consistent data collection tools for Communication, Literacy and Numeracy (OneSchool dashboard and school data wall) and provide data Literacy training to teachers and school leaders.
- Appoint a Head of Teaching and Learning (in partnership with Redcliffe Special School) to ensure a seamless curriculum journey for all special school students within the Redcliffe Peninsula catchment.
- Provide coaching and mentoring for teachers and aides in the use of digital media for Literacy and Communication.
- Continue to engage with the regional Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL) coach.
